Letter of recommendation from the following: 4-H Extension Agent, 4-H Club Leader, Pastor/Youth Pastor, or Coach. The person of your choosing cannot be a relative.

7. Students applying for the scholarship will apply on the form provided by the ISRBA. Please mail or email the completed application along with the letter of recommendation, transcript, and the essay, to the ISRBA Scholarship chairman.
8. All complete applications should be mailed with a postmark no later than July 1st to the Scholarship chairman.
